- 2) **Hora Medal** is awarded to a student of Final Year of B.Com (H) or B.A. (H) Economics or M.A. Economics or M.Com for outstanding participation and organization of extra-curricular activities in the College.
- 3) **Dhani Ram Medals** are awarded to the best Debators of the year one in Hindi and One in English.
- 4) **Principal Madan Mohan Medal** is awarded to a student who has to his credit maximum active participation in extra-curricular activities during the year.

MEDALS & PRIZES

- Punj Lloyd Gold Medal is awarded to the topper of the Global Business Operation Programme across all years taken together.
- Prem Pandhi Gold Medal is awarded to best post graduate student to be judged on the basis of overall performance of students in academics, attendance, conduct, participation and credits/awards in extra-curricular activities and sports activities in the first two semesters of post graduate diploma in Global Business Operations (GBO).
- Kamla Mehrotra Gold Medal is awarded to B.Com.(Hons.) overall topper.
- Tajpal Aggarwal Gold Medal is awarded to B.Com. (Hons.) 1 year topper.
- Arun Chachra Memorial Gold Medal is awarded to B.A.(Hons.) Economics overall topper.
- Dr. Charat Ram Gold Medal is awarded to B.A. (Hons.) Economics II year topper.
- Shri G.L. Bansal Gold Medal is awarded to B.A. (Hons.) Economics I year topper.
- M.C. Kuchhal Gold Medal is awarded to a B.Com. (Hons.) third year student who secures highest marks in aggregate in two papers, i.e. Business Law and Corporate Law of B.Com. (Hons.) first year and second year respectively.
- Principal Jai Narayan Vaish Memorial Medals are awarded to those students who secure first position in B.Com and M.Com. in the College, at the Degree and Post-graduate Examinations and have consistently obtained First Class marks in all examinations.
- Kumari Archana Agrawal Memorial Medal and Cash Prize of ₹ 1,000 are awarded to a girl student of B.Com (Hons.) who secures the highest percentage of marks in all the three years combined and has cleared these examinations in the first attempt.
- R.L. Gupta Medal is awarded to a student of B.Com (Hons.) III Year who secures the highest percentage of marks in Advanced Accountancy and has consistently obtained First Division marks in B.Com. (Hons.) I and II Year examinations.
- Suniti Goyal Medal is awarded to III Year girl topper in B.A. (Hons.) Economics.
- Hora Medal is awarded to a student of Final Year of B.Com. (Hons.) or B.A. (Hons.) Economics or M.A. Economics or M.Com. for outstanding participation and organisation of extra-curricular activities in the College. The criteria/weightage for award of medal is as under:

• Organizing ability	60%
• Leadership Quality	20%
• Active participation in various extracurricular activities	20%

- Dhani Ram Medals are awarded to the best debators of the year one in Hindi and one in English. The medals will be awarded to any student, who has to his/her credit maximum active participation in debating during the year, provided that no student shall be awarded medals more than once.

Best debater will be decided on the basis of the following criteria:

Prizes	Weightage In College Function	Weightage In Inter-College Function
1 st Prize	10%	40%
2 nd Prize	5%	20%
3 rd Prize	2%	10%
Consolation Prize or Sharing a Trophy	2%	5%
Participation	1%	5%

- Principal Madan Mohan Medal is awarded to a student who has to his credit maximum active participation in extra-curricular activities during the year. The criteria/weightage for award of medal is as under:

• Sports	40%
• Extracurricular activities including debating	50%
• Debating	10%
- Social Service Medal is awarded to the best social worker of the College for the year.

Note : For the purposes of Principal Madan Mohan Medal, Dhani Ram Medals and Social Service Medal, 'Year' means the period starting from the previous year's Awards Committee meeting to the current year's Awards Committee meeting.

Academic Prizes

There are three prizes in the I, II and III Year classes of B.Com. (Hons.) and three prizes in the I, II and III Year classes of B.A. (Hons.) Economics. Likewise, there are two prizes in Year I and Year II of M.Com., M.A. Economics and Global Business Operations.

Skand Gupta Memorial Prize of ₹ 1000/- to a student of B.A. (H) Eco. II year who scores highest marks in the Compulsory Language (English) Credit Course paper in the preceeding year.

Manohar Lal Memorial Prize of ₹ 1,000/- be awarded to a student of B.A. (H) Eco. II and III year or B.Com (H) III year who has scored the highest marks in Hindi in the preceeding year in the credit course paper.

Sir Shri Ram Memorial Debate Trophy

The Sir Shri Ram Memorial Debate was initiated during the Golden Jubilee of the College. In all these years it has become one of the most reputed debates in Delhi University. Since last year SRM Debate has become a national event held alongside the National Debating Festival. The debate is bilingual and comes with a silver
