Minutes of the Meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) dated July 2nd, 2025

At the onset of the meeting, the Principal welcomed all the Members. The Agenda points were tabled for discussion and following resolutions were adopted:

Resolution 1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the previous IQAC Meeting held on 29th November 2024 (Agenda Point 1)

The IQAC confirmed the minutes of its previous meeting held on 29th November 2024.

Resolution 2: Discussion on the Quality Initiatives to be Undertaken for the Centenary (Agenda Point 2)

The IQAC outlined the quality initiatives to be undertaken for the upcoming Centenary in 2026, which are listed as follows:

- i) It was discussed that the Centenary celebrations would span the entire year of 2026, with major events to be held in both semesters. The potential involvement of the President or the Prime

Minister as the Chief Guest during the opening and valedictory sessions is anticipated. However, external venues may be required due to security concerns.

- ii) While three publications titled *100 Years of Yamuna Poems (Hindi)*, *100 Years of Yamuna Poems (English)* and *100 Years in Pictures* are ready, by the end of the year, additional publications covering milestones of SRCC, and albums on important individuals of the College (both past and present) will also be completed. The external members of the IQAC proposed the inclusion of publications featuring illustrious alumni and distinguished authors from the College, and the creation of a repository of such collections.
- iii) The IQAC informed that interviews with alumni are ongoing and their details are being posted on LinkedIn and also the designs for the commemorative stamps, coins and the event calendar have been finalized and will be released in due course.

Resolution 3: Updates on the Quality Initiatives Undertaken in the Last Quarter (Agenda Point 3)

Under this resolution, the quality initiatives undertaken by the College in the last quarter are listed below:

Academic and Research Initiatives

- i) The IQAC was pleased to inform that SRCC has been ranked as the number one Commerce College in India by the India Today Rankings, based on the latest data released last week.
- ii) The IQAC informed that discussions are ongoing with IIT Madras regarding the launch of a collaborative degree programme.
- iii) As part of the MMTTC initiatives, SRCC successfully launched and conducted teacher training programmes for teachers of Classes 11 and 12. The first of these was held for Class 12 teachers, training 78 educators from top schools in Delhi on the topic of “Accounting and Taxation”.
- iv) Under the aegis of SRCC IQAC, the International Conference on AI for Social Impact (ICAISI 2025) was successfully organized on 25th and 26th June 2025 at Gulf Medical University in Ajman, United Arab Emirates. The event was hosted in collaboration with Thumbay College of Management and AI in Healthcare at GMU. The theme of the conference was "Transforming Business, Healthcare, and Policy for Sustainable Development," with a focus on the responsible application of Artificial Intelligence across business, healthcare and governance, in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. The conference attracted participants from 37 universities and institutions across five countries, and received a total of 60 abstract submissions.

Alumni Meets in India and United Arab Emirates

- i) The IQAC informed that a networking dinner was held on 4 May 2025 at the Taj Mansingh Hotel in New Delhi. The event brought together over 78 notable alumni from batches ranging from 1964 to 2017 to celebrate SRCC's legacy and mark the beginning of a new era of excellence with alumni engagement.
- ii) As a precursor to the Centenary festivities, an alumni gathering was also organized in Dubai on 14 June 2025 at the Towers Rotana Hotel. The event was carefully coordinated by the SRCC UAE alumni network and attracted 108 alumni from across the region.

Resolution 4: Any Other Matter with Permission of the Chair (Agenda Point 4)

No other matter was discussed by the IQAC members.
