






Events and Activities conducted by NSS during 2022-2023 for gender sensitization

PURPLE DAY CELEBRATION

The Social Empowerment wing of the National Service Scheme at Shri Ram College of Commerce celebrated Purple Day on August 26, 2023. Purple Day is celebrated annually to raise awareness against the bullying taking place against the LGBTQIA+ community. People wear purple clothes or accessories to show their solidarity. Decorations were carried out by the Creative and Organizing wing of the unit, aided by the entire cabinet of NSS. People were encouraged to wear purple, and the significance of this color was explained to individuals by the Social Empowerment heads. Notes were distributed amongst everyone, and ribbons were tied on the wrists of those who could not wear purple. The event saw a footfall of 200+ people from the college. By promoting dialogue, education, and allyship, colleges play a vital role in shaping future leaders who are committed to creating a more just and equitable society for all, regardless of sexual orientation or gender identity.







GENDER EQUALITY SESSION

Project Sanskar, a part of the National Service Scheme at Shri Ram College of Commerce, partnered with the Rotaract Club of Delhi School of Economics to host a session on Gender Equality on July 1, 2023. The session was designed to engage students creatively, prompting them to draw images of a doctor and a teacher on paper. Interestingly, most students depicted a male doctor and a female teacher. This observation became a teaching moment, emphasizing that professions are not inherently gender specific. Approximately 25-30 students participated in the session, gaining a deeper understanding of the importance of gender equality.
