Mathematics is an essential prerequisite for modern Economics. A score of 70% in Mathematics is a minimum requirement for those wishing to do Economics.
3	For determining the percentage of marks scored at the qualifying examination only four subjects will be counted as follows: (I) English : and (II) Three other subjects in the Commerce, Science and Humanities streams respectively, which would not include any other language, Computer Science, Mechanical Drawing, Art, Needle-work and Dress Making, Cookery, Physical Education, Home Science, Music Business Mathematics, Environment Studies and similar subjects. NOTE:

* To elucidate, if a candidate in Category B has 93% marks, his/her marks are equivalent to 94% marks in Category A, and if a candidate in Category C has 90% marks, his/her marks are equivalent to 91% in Category A.

The student who is admitted to B.Com.(Hons.), which is an academic course, should possess theoretical and analytical competence which may not be provided by the study of vocational papers such as, Needle-work and Dress-Making, Cookery, Physical Education, Entrepreneurship, Environmental Studies, Home Science, Music, Fashion Studies, Typing and Shorthand, Computer Science and similar subjects.

To elucidate, if a candidate in category E has 97% marks, his/her marks are equivalent to 95% marks in Category A. An additional eligibility criterion (as mentioned in point 2) is not applicable to candidates applying under SC/ST and PwD Category.



ANNEXURE II

FORMS TO BE FILLED AND DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED WITH THE ADMISSION FORM

- a. Fill a separate **Admission Form** (available from the College office) and affix your recent passport size photograph at specified place.
- b. Fill University Enrolment Form (available from the College office).
- c. Fill form for Identity Card (available from the College office) and affix your recent passport size photograph at specified place.

- d. Marks Sheet of passing Class XII examination (Qualifying examination).
- e. Certificate of Date of Birth (High School Certificate – Class X).
- f. Character Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution last attended.
- g. Provisional Certificate of passing the Qualifying Examination (Class XII) from the institution last attended.
- h. Migration Certificate, in case the student is from a Board/University other than Delhi.
- i. Certificate from the Head of the School stating that the candidate has passed Hindi language upto class VIII in case candidate has not studied Hindi language in class X or XII. This certificate would be required for exemption from Compulsory Test in Hindi (CTH). Candidates (except foreign nationals) who have not studied Hindi at all or upto a standard lower than class VIII would be required to pass CTH conducted by the University of Delhi at later stage in current year.
- j. Caste/Category certificate (if admitted under any reserved category). The caste/category certificate should be issued in the name of the candidate concerned. The certificate of OBC candidates must mention non-creamy layer status of the candidate and the caste must be included in the Central List for OBC's. Income certificate of parents for the financial year 2013-14 would be required for justifying non-creamy layer status of candidate in case OBC certificate is dated earlier than June, 2013.
- k. Relevant sports certificates, in case candidate is admitted under Sports Quota.
- l. Admission Order/Slip from the University in case candidate seeking admission under Armed Forces/Foreign/Kashmiri Migrant categories.
- m. **All certificates/documents in original as mentioned above.**

In addition to above each candidate would be required to submit Anti-ragging Affidavits in a prescribed format on stamp paper duly signed by the student and parent. (The format of affidavits will be provided by the college).
