We strive to lead

We are privileged to have committed, award winning faculty, distinguished for their academic and administrative acumen, bringing the wealth of their consulting, research and policy-making experience into the classroom. This is perfectly complemented by the students who have great potential, hold diverse interests and are completely focused on what they want to achieve.

We have a bias towards action

With an unequivocal orientation towards practical and pragmatic thinking, our programmes build management initiative, responsibility and discipline. Our faculty members are actively associated with industry and contribute to contemporary research, while our students are guided to relate to current business practices and concerns. We insist on both conceptual rigour in analysis and pragmatism in action.

We continuously innovate

At SRCC, we learn from each other. As a direct result of this attitude to experimentation, SRCC has been a pace-setter for business practices in the country. Purely academic programmes are continuously monitored and improved upon, with inputs from students, alumni and industry.

We have a global focus

Education at SRCC has a well-rounded international perspective that imparts business skills and qualities to meet global needs. With the needs of an ever-changing world scenario, accelerated personal interactions, multicultural business environments, improvisation and innovation, SRCC is privileged to avail itself of the global opportunities and build on its reputation for excellence in business education. As the students, alumni and faculty will attest for, SRCC's reputation as a contemporary, real-world commerce-college is well earned. We are confident of engaging with the new world, with its endless possibilities, seeking new roles and new avenues to improve upon.

Visioning and Internationalization

Internationalization is to possess a perspective that transcends beyond the confines of national boundaries, be they geographical or otherwise. The main thrust of going international is to have a mental makeover of acceptance, inclusiveness and sensitivity. In addition, we strive to inculcate a knowledge system that is global so that our students can always benchmark themselves at a higher level of excellence. We stress the need for enriching opportunities through international collaborations in research, courses and executive programmes, intensive short-term programmes for students and cultural activities, improving the brand equity of SRCC among international recruiters. It also has the potential of enhancing our research output in tier-I refereed journals. This is reflected in the various academic collaborations that SRCC is a proud participant of.

Since 1997, Shri Ram College of Commerce has been ranked as the number one commerce

college in the country. However, the College cannot remain complacent but instead has to work even harder to be exceptional and keep bettering its earlier achievements. The foundation for the truly exceptional, I believe, must be rooted in illustrious research, through citations, faculty development and visibility. Closer links with industry and academia, strong alumni network, vibrant student support system, high level of ethics and transparency in governance and sound financial base will make the institution live up to its brand-image. A brief elaboration on these strategic issues is shared below.

Research

SRCC must create a supportive environment to raise the level of quality, quantity, accessibility, impact and sustainability of its research programmes by hosting of international or national research conferences, conducting baseline external assessment of the quality and relevance of its research, encouraging academic staff to publish their research in high impact journals, recognizing and rewarding innovative research-active scholars, strengthening research collaborations nationally and internationally, negotiate with donors and corporate organizations for research funding and create appropriate research infrastructure.

Faculty

SRCC must make provision for appointing top-calibre professors. This is an unquestionable component needed to elevate SRCC to the highest strata of excellence. Such professors must be 'academic leaders' in terms of intellectual rigour, commanding relevance and artful exposition. These professors ought to be transformational intellectuals, whose insights are grounded on profound understanding of practice. Furthermore, such faculty should be able to carry out diversified research on all relevant fields of study and build visibility for themselves as well as for SRCC through peer-reviewed publications, conference presentations and proceedings.

Industry-Academia Collaboration

SRCC must build active relationships with corporate and academic world globally which is an essential ingredient to gain global recognition. Industry and academic interactions ought to be designed to ensure that SRCC is continuously addressing important business and academic issues and providing its corporate and academic constituencies with intellectual renewal that is critical to success in today's competitive environment.

Alumni

SRCC must capitalize on the strength and international reach of its alumni network. SRCC has not yet tapped its alumni base significantly. The interconnectedness between College and its alumni provides an opportunity to bond meaningfully with the alma mater. The alumni's sense of belongingness to the college is an emotional attachment and hence SRCC needs to build and strengthen these very vital linkages.

Governance

To maintain the highest level of integrity, SRCC must make concerted efforts towards fundamental governance principles:(a) to strengthen collegial organization (shared governance, faculty role) wherever possible, (b) ensure robust consultative process (involvement, participation of those affected) when decisions at the centre have significant effects on departments, college or other units, (c) promote a culture of openness throughout the college, maximizing transparency, information, and communication, and (d) expect the highest standards of ethical conduct for all members of the college community, especially for those who occupy leadership or authority positions and whose decision have a significant impact on others.

Student Exposure to Global Pactices

SRCC must enhance the success of its students by improving learning environment and enrich campus-life through a greater variety of cross-cultural experiences, thereby strengthening national and global consciousness across student body.

Endowment

No institution can be great without a sound financial base. Large endowment funds could be the basis of attracting and retaining the words class faculty, adequate infrastructure facilities for academic work and student quality-of-life on campus, buying sophisticated equipment for support services and providing generous scholarships to deserving and needy students.





SRCC must explore all possible avenues for generating funds to carry out its vision - "SRCC: A College of Global Choice" by its Centenary in 2026.

George Bernard Shaw once wrote, "The reasonable man adapts himself to the world; the unreasonable one persists in trying to adapt the world to himself. Therefore, all progress depends on the unreasonable man," and hence my humble advice to you all is to create an environment of tolerance for failure where several unreasonable women and men across the globe will gather and build "SRCC: A College of Global Choice."

Let me also share with you the tentative road-map of what we as an institution are looking forward to. The quality of teaching-learning imparted in an academic institution is directly influenced by its faculty, which plays the pivotal role in shaping the destinies of its students. The College is in the process of developing a dedicated 'Good Practices Cell' which will work towards excellence in all walks of college life, of both students as well as teachers. In anticipation of the continually changing scenario of higher education in India and abroad as well as newer challenges emerging out of specific contexts, we are working towards promoting a holistic exchange of ideas and unique teaching-learning practices within the faculty, to build upon our existing rich resource base, by making optimal use of not just formal strategies like brain-storming, panel-discussions, orientations and workshops, but also informal interactions on a day-to-day basis.
