## **Description of roles for student division of Centre for Green Initiatives**

The student division of Centre for Green Initiatives, SRCC is a matrix organisation with four individual units, each headed by a faculty member under the overall coordination of the Coordinator, CGI. Student across all years (I, II and III year) and all courses (B.Com (Hons), B.A. (Hons) Economics and PGDGBO) are eligible to apply for CGI positions. The role under the various wings are:

**1. Operations:** Role includes-

- a. Managing overall coordination between various student units of the CGI
- b. Facilitation of generation of student ideas towards conservation and better employment of environmental resources
- c. Organising periodical events & speaker sessions/workshops for students of SRCC
- d. Organising and Management of **Tatva**-The Annual Green Festival of SRCC

**2. Editorial & Research:** Role includes-

- a. Creation of two periodical publications of the Centre for Green Initiatives-the periodical **Newsletter** and **Avni**, our annual magazine including collection and editing of articles, design, photography and spread of magazine.
- b. Research includes field work on research projects and writing research papers/articles on various environment related topics for publication in **Avni/Newsletter**.

**3. Creative:** Role includes-

- a. Creation of art and decoration for the CGI greenboards around the campus
- b. Aiding in decoration during various events
- c. Creation of designs for newsletters, videos and other educational material in fulfilment of the functions of CGI

**4. Public Relations:** Role includes-

- a. Generating awareness amongst students of SRCC towards the environmental issues and initiatives
- b. Facilitating sponsorship for events of CGI
- c. Creation of **Brochures** and other content for spreading awareness of the CGI and its initiatives amongst the students
