

Financial Literacy Programme of SRCC


The College has set up the **Centre for Community Engagement (CCE)** to work proactively with the communities on major development issues. The Centre has launched a Financial Education Programme to promote financial literacy and enhance the knowledge and skills to manage financial resources and services effectively amongst students and other community stakeholders.


The programme is multi-faceted involving training of trainers, peer - counseling, developing interactive apps and events to promote financial literacy with respect to:

- Basics of Financial Planning
- Channelising of savings
- Investments
- Managing credits and students' loan
- Banking and Insurance services
- Opening and operating of bank accounts
- Related Government Schemes, etc.

The programme on financial education will be for a year starting from April 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017 and will be conducted through students interns of SRCC after providing necessary training. The interns will get certification from the College on putting a minimum of 120 hours for the programme.
