Registration-Cum-Admission for Certificate Course in Foreign Language-French

Foreign Language Cell, Shri Ram College of Commerce (FLC-SRCC) invites applications for the Part-Time Certificate Course in Foreign Language-French.

Course Fee: Rs. 12,310 (for SRCC students) / Rs. 18,210 (for Other College Students)
(Including GST and University Examination Fee)

Course Duration: 120-150 hours (6 hours per week from Oct, 2022-Mar/Apr, 2023)

This course is conducted as per the official guidelines of University of Delhi and is affiliated to the Department of Germanic and Romance Studies (GRS), University of Delhi.

The registrations are open for all the students of Undergraduate and Postgraduate studying in SRCC and other colleges affiliated to the University of Delhi. Course is not open to the general public.

Interested students are required to fill in the registration form latest by September 25, 2022. Students are advised to read the General Guidelines attached with notice before proceeding.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

Important Information:

1. Registrations are invited from students studying in Shri Ram College of Commerce and other colleges affiliated to University of Delhi only.
2. Maximum number of seats is 100. Candidates shall be shortlisted on merit basis in case of excess applications are received. Minimum 40 successful registrations are required in the course and without minimum registrations, the course shall not be commenced and fee received shall be refunded.
3. The selected candidates will be required to pay the fee in full upon confirmation of their selection. Fee shall be received in online-mode only. **The fee once paid shall not be refundable or transferable.**
4. On the commencement of the course, it is mandatory for the students to attend all the classes pertaining to the course. University Guidelines regarding minimum attendance shall be applicable for appearing in Final Examination.
5. The total duration of the course shall be 120-150 hours (6 months to 7 months). The classes shall be scheduled from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM and three days a week. If required, classes may be conducted on Sunday and public holiday as well.
6. The classes will be conducted in offline mode. Some classes may be conducted in online mode but not more than 1/3rd of the total classes shall be conducted in online mode.
7. The college reserves the right to revoke the admission of any student found in any act of indiscipline, misbehaving with peers and staff or damaging the college property.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

Candidates who have passed their Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2) from the recognised board or an examination recognised as equivalent with an aggregate of at least 45% marks are eligible to apply. No prior proficiency in French is required.

Certification of the Course

Certificate of the course shall be awarded by the University of Delhi after successfully passing the examination as per University rules.

Admission Process:

- Interested students may apply for the course by filling the registration form shared through Google Form link in this notice. (Link can also be accessed in Announcement Section of SRCC website)
- The names of the provisionally selected students with waiting list will be put up in a notice on the college website. Provisionally selected students will also receive a mail from foreignlanguage@srcc.du.ac.in Selection shall be made on merit basis if number of applicants is more than the number of seats. Merit list shall be prepared as per marks scored in 12th standard.
- Provisionally selected students will be required to deposit the fee in online mode as per instructions. A separate notice for fee payment will be published on the college website (Announcement Section).
- After successful submission of fee, students will be required to submit the self –attested hard copies of their documents (mentioned below) along with fee receipt to the college Admin Office. A final selection list will be prepared and published on the college website before the commencement of classes.

Tentative Timeline

Registration Opens: 19th September, 2022

Registration Closes: 25th September, 2022

Announcement of First Merit List: 26th September, 2022

Announcement of Second Merit List: 01st October, 2022

Commencement of Classes: From 1st Week of October, 2022

Note:

1. Announcement of second list is subject to availability of seats.
2. Fee payment details will be shared with the announcement of merit list. Selected students will be required to deposit the fee within 3(three) working days from the date of publication of the list.
3. Following successful fee payment, selected candidates will be notified of further admission process and physical documents verification through FLC-SRCC official email-id.

Scheme of Examination

Examination for the Certificate Course shall be conducted by the Shri Ram College of Commerce in coordination with the Department of Germanic and Romance Studies as per the date sheet published by DU for the Part-Time Courses. Registered students will be required to fill a separate examination form for certificate course on the University website when university opens the link. Generally, this link is opened by University in December/January month.

Normally the examinations of part time courses are held in the month of April. Students who pursue a part time language course as well as other course/s from University of Delhi /any other university simultaneously may note that the college does not take any responsibility for adjustment of dates for the annual examination. Students may also note that they can pursue only one part time language course at a time.

Functional grammar based on the textbook

Paper II Text Comprehension and Written Expression 100

Comprehension of simple texts and précis-writing 40

Essays on simple topics, questions on civilisation 40

Translation of simple passages into English and simple sentences into the foreign language 20

Paper III Oral Expression 100

Reading of texts, general questions on the country and civilisation.
