I am pleased to inform you that the University of Delhi is participating in the "Global Citizenship Program for Young Leaders" being organized by the Australia India Institute, Univ. of Melbourne during October 1-9, 2011. This program will engage talented students from various countries with the opportunities and challenges of Global citizenship through a dedicated program planned by the Australia India Institute. The program will explore the varied dimensions of what it means to be a global citizen in the 21st century.

The University of Delhi has planned to send **10 undergraduate students** (who are in the II or III year) from its constituent colleges, and they will be selected in the final round by a committee constituted by the University. Expenses towards Air-travel, Visa, Medical Insurance, lodging and Boarding will be borne by the University.

I) Selection procedure

- a) The attached documents describe the salient features of the program.
- b) We request each college to **select up to 4 students** after screening the applications received in the college through a Committee.
- c) The **poster** announcing the call for applications should be well advertised on all Notice boards prominently and on the website of the College. (sample copy enclosed).
- d) The names of the **4 selected students in order of priority(rank order)** along with their applications, parent's consent and teacher's recommendations should be sent to the University.
- e) Each college will select two students from Humanities, Social Science and Commerce stream and two students from Science and Mathematical Science stream.

Two-stage Selection Process: 1) Initial round at the College

2) Final selection to be done by the University

The Global Citizenship Programme for Young Leaders University of Delhi and University of Melbourne

The Global Citizenship Programme for Young Leaders will engage talented students with the opportunities and challenges of Global Citizenship through a dedicated programme by the Australia India Institute.

Major Features:

The Programme will explore the varied dimensions of what it means to be a global citizen in the 21st century including:

- ❖ The nature of the global economy
- ❖ Multiculturalism
- ❖ Human rights and ethics
- ❖ Traditional cultures
- ❖ Climate change and environmental challenges
- ❖ Urbanization
- ❖ Global health
- ❖ Superpower relations
- ❖ The changing role of global security and
- ❖ Cross cultural communication
- ❖ Gandhi and contemporary India

I) Selection procedure

- a) Students will submit their application forms A and B to the Principal's office in their college.
- b) Each college will select four students after screening the applications received in the college. The college will constitute a screening committee.
- c) The names of the four selected students, in order of priority e.g. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th along with their applications, parent's consent and teacher recommendations will be forwarded to the University.
- d) Each college will select two students from Humanities, Social Science and Commerce stream and two students from Science and Mathematical Science stream.
- e) Final selection will be done by the University.

II) Selection Criteria

Ten(10) students would be shortlisted by the University out of the names received from the colleges on the following criteria of weightage

- (i) Academic performance in the University examination-40%
- (ii) Co-curricular activities-10%
- (iii) Statement of purpose(200 words)-20%
- (iv) Interview-30%

Students those who have not been abroad earlier would be given preference. Students would be required to defend/explain their statement of purpose during the interview. The colleges shall apply the same weightage for selecting the students.

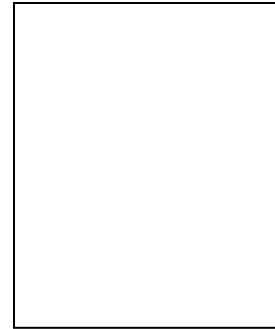
