INDO-BHUTAN YOUTH SUMMIT 2018

2018 marks 50 years of friendship and diplomatic relations between the two countries and the launch of the Indo-Bhutan Youth Summit commemorates this milestone in the enduring friendship and partnership between these two nations.

The main objective of the youth summit is to enhance the ties between the youth of both countries and create an understanding of the importance of building India-Bhutan friendship. The Summit will also create a pool of potential ambassadors, in both countries, who will carry forward the collaboration for the next 50 years. The summit will provide an opportunity for the youth to engage in meaningful conversations on various aspects of India-Bhutan collaboration.

To start with, this exclusive Fellowship will bring selected candidates together to the Kingdom of Bhutan and offer them a first-hand experience of living and learning in a country where environment, ancient traditions and values are being preserved carefully while walking the road to modernization. The India leg of the programme will be conducted in India next year. The selected Fellows, the brightest young minds from different parts of Bhutan and India, will exchange ideas, experiences, knowledge and perspectives on issues impacting our world. At the same time, the experience will serve to give them a more informed understanding of the various challenges facing this young democracy and its growing economy. The Fellowship will cover airfare, visa fees, accommodation and all meals.

The programme will be structured in a manner where learning experiences will incorporate a combination of academics and adventure. It will include an introduction to Bhutan, interactions amongst the participants on core issues, meetings between the participants and eminent persons in Bhutan.

The nine-day journey will also include a trek across the pristine land of Bhutan, where participants will visit places of interest and interact with people to gain a better understanding of the country and the aspirations of its citizens. The nine-day summit is scheduled to commence on 21st September 2018. At the end of the programme, the candidates would be asked to share their experiences and continue to remain part of the Indo-Bhutan Youth Summit community that will only grow over the years.
