All submissions must be in Time New Roman 12 pt; a 1-inch margin on all sides; and ranging between 2500 and 3000 words excluding Tables, Figures, and References. In-text citations and listing of the references must be in APA 7 style of referencing.

Submissions must clearly mention the name(s) of the author(s), the role of author(s) (main author/co-author/corresponding), affiliation(s), contact number(s), and corresponding Email ID(s) of the author(s).

The submission categories acceptable in the seminar are as stated below:

- Conceptual paper (Based on literature review with research implications and future research directions, research models, theory related)
- **Empirical research paper** (quantitative, qualitative, and mixed methodology)
- Policy research paper (critically examining national or international policies)
- Case studies (without teaching notes).
