Please use only black ball point pen for writing/marking on OMR answer sheet.

BAN ON ELECTRONIC GADGETS

Candidates must note that electronic gadgets like mobile phones, calculators, tablets, etc are NOT ALLOWED to be brought within the EXAMINATION CENTRE PREMISES. Do not carry them with you. The centre may not have arrangements for safe keep of the gadgets. Candidates in possession of any type of electronic or non-electronic gadget having features of doing calculations, making/processing communication or data storage during examination shall be liable for cancellation of their examination.

THE TEST

The test consists of one paper of 2 hours duration. The paper will consist of 160 questions, 40 in each subject (40 on English Comprehension and Language Ability, 40 on Quantitative Ability, 40 on Reasoning and Logical Ability and 40 on Data Interpretation). Test is of objective type. A sealed test booklet will be provided with the answer sheet placed inside it. Each question will be followed by four responses marked (1), (2), (3) and (4). Of these four responses, only one will be correct or the most appropriate response.

SCORING AND NEGATIVE MARKING Each question will carry 4 marks. The total marks of the Paper would be 640. For each correct response, the candidate will get 4 marks. For each incorrect response one mark will be deducted from the total score.

ANSWER SHEET AND CHECKING OF SERIAL NUMBER The answer sheet will be found placed inside the booklet. It will carry a serial number and series which should tally with the serial number and series on the Test Booklet. Candidate should immediately bring to the notice of the invigilator any discrepancy she/he finds in the serial number on the test booklet and the answer sheet placed inside it. In such an event she/he should have her/his booklet and answer sheet replaced. In any case the candidate is not to use an answer sheet which has a different serial number and series than the one given on the Test Booklet.


HOW TO USE THE ANSWER SHEET

In the answer sheet the serial number of question is given in a row, which corresponds to the question number in the Test Booklet. In each column there are four circles which correspond to the four responses of that question.

Candidates will find out the right answer to the question and will darken the appropriate circle with black ball point pen only.

- Q.22. The natural satellite(s) of the Earth is / are:
 - (1) Moon
 - (2) Planetesimals
 - (3) Comet
 - (4) All of the above

The correct response to this question is (1) Moon. The candidate will locate column 22 in the answer sheet and will darken the circle (1) as shown below:





CHANGING AN ANSWER IS NOT POSSIBLE

Candidates must mark answers option when they are fully sure. No change is possible when an answer has been marked with ball point pen.

The candidates are, therefore, advised to decide about the answer before they mark it on the answer sheet. A lightly or faintly darkened circle will also be treated as wrong method of marking and will be treated as wrong answer.

ROUGH WORK

All Rough Work is to be done in the test booklet only. The candidate will not do any rough work or put stray mark on the answer sheet.

NOTE

- Each candidate must show on demand her/his Admission Ticket bearing her/his Roll Number, for admission to the Examination Hall.
- A seat with roll number will be allotted to each candidate. Candidates must find out and occupy their allotted seats.
- 3. No candidate, without the permission of the Superintendent, or the Invigilator concerned, is to leave her/his seat or the Examination Room before conclusion of examination duration, i.e. before 12.00 noon. Candidates should not leave the Examination Hall without handing over their OMR Answer Sheet to the Invigilator on duty. Candidates will be allowed to take away with them their test booklets only after examination concludes, i.e after 12.00 noon.
- 4. The candidates should not take any article in the Examination Hall except Admission Ticket, instruction sheet and ball point pens. - Tea, coffee, cold drinks or snacks are not allowed to be taken into the Examination rooms during examination hours.
- Candidates appearing without photograph on their Admission Ticket will not be allowed to take examination.

Candidates are advised to bring at least one photo identification card with them, viz. Driving License, Voter I Card, Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, College I Card, or Employment Card.

During the examination time, the Invigilators will check admission tickets of the candidates to satisfy themselves about the identity of each candidate. The Invigilators will also check that candidates have filled in the particulars correctly. The invigilator will also put his signature in the Box provided in the Answer Sheet.



A signal bell will be given at the beginning of the Examination and at half time. A signal bell will also be given 5 minutes before the closing time and at the closing time, when the candidates must stop marking the responses.

Instructions for filling in information and marking the answers on the answer sheet

- Use black ball pen only to blacken the circles in various columns of the answer-sheet. Any mark made by any other device shall not be read by the machine and may lead to the cancellation of your answer-sheet.
- A negative score will be given for every question in which more than one circle is blackened in any column or a wrong answer is given.
- Since there is no possibility to change the marked answer once a circle is blackened by ball pen, candidates are advised to be careful before marking their answer option.
- Suppose the name of candidate is Chaman Bhai Maganbhai Desai, his Roll No. is 128320, the booklet series issued to him
 is 'B', the test form no. of the booklet is 258 and his category is General, the entry should be made illustrated as under:
