Subject: Y20 Summit 2016 – nomination of Youth

Sir,

I am directed to inform you that Y20 Summit is being organized in Beijing from 31st July to 6th August 2016. The Y20 Summit is the official platform for young people from across G20 countries to engage in policy discussions on the most pressing global economic challenges and generate innovative solutions which will be presented to the G20 Leaders' Summit for consideration.

2. Five nominations have been sought from India for the Y20 Summit. Therefore, you are requested to forward names of 2 meritorious Young students from your College/ University who are well versed in issues pertaining to international political economy. While recommending names, preference may be given to the youth who are associated with NSS volunteer activities.

3. The Youth being recommended should meet the following eligibility criteria:

(i) The nominated youth should not be more than 30 years of age as on 01.01.2016;

(ii) the nominated youth should be the regular student with excellent track record;

(iii) the nominated youth should not have been sent abroad on government expenditure in the past;


(iv) there shall be no case pending on the proposed youth in any court of law;

(v) the nominated youth should possess a valid Indian passport as on date.

4. The names of the youth / student alongwith their contact numbers, email, contact address, scanned copy of passport, scanned copy of passport size photograph may be sent to this Ministry on priority basis by return mail latest by 10.06.2016. Detailed nominations, duly filled in by each participant with a recent colored passport size photograph (white background), may be forwarded subsequently in the enclosed proforma latest by 15.06.2016. A brief description of the exceptional qualities of the nominee (in about 100 words) may also be forwarded along with the application form. Nominations received after 10.06.2015 in the Ministry will not be considered.

5. Forwarding of nominations does not entail selection. A nomination received with incomplete information would be summarily be rejected. The Ministry holds sole discretion in further selection of delegates. The students may also be advised not to use other channels for follow up/ influence/ feedback etc.
