'The RBI Policy Challenge - 2019'
A National Level Competition for Under Graduate / Post Graduate students

As the Central Bank of the country, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is committed to spreading awareness regarding financial matters and promotion of better understanding of monetary and economic issues. Towards this, we launched a National-Level competition titled 'The RBI Policy Challenge' in 2015-16. Targeted at Under Graduate and Post Graduate students pursuing any discipline in select Universities / colleges/ Institutes of Excellence in the country, the three-tier competition tests essay —writing, problem solving and presentation skills of the participants. The idea has been well received with previous editions of the competition receiving good response.

- 2. We are pleased to now announce the schedule for 'The RBI Policy Challenge- 2019' which would be conducted as per the following programme:
- Regional Round (Only for academic institutions located in NCT of Delhi): This would involve writing an essay on a given topic by students in groups of 3 or 4 guided by a faculty adviser. Details regarding the topic, maximum word limit, assessment criteria, last date for receipt of entries, etc. are enclosed. Team writing the best essay, as assessed by the expert(s), would advance to the Zonal Round.
- Zonal Round (At RBI Regional Office in Delhi on February 01, 2019): Each team would be invited to present a Paper before a panel comprising external experts as also field a few questions posed by the panelists. The winning team from each Zone would advance to the National Round.
