SRCC-PENN STATE INDO-US COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMME

The History: The SRCC-Penn State Collaborative Program was conceived in July 2012 during a brief three-day visit to SRCC by students and faculty members from the Schreyer Honors College, Pennsylvania State University, USA. The students bonded very well and the buddy system seemed to be synergetic for the cross-country learning process. The exhilarating response received catapulted a small initiative to a ten-day collaborative programme with a vision to pair students with diverse cultural ties and foster learning about contemporary issues.

The Programme: The SRCC-PennState collaborative programme aims to sensitize the participants towards understanding multicultural social diversity and in the process, foster new bonds of friendship. The ten day interactive programme encapsulates:

- ❖ Lecture series by reputed Professors and subject experts
- **Visit** to the President's Estate and the Parliament
- **Excursions** to historical landmarks and places of social and cultural interest in Delhi
- **Workshops** on Ancient Indian art and culture
- **Cultural Programme** on Indo-US fusion
- **Comprehensive Group Projects** on integrated topics

Group Project:

An integral part of the Programme is the group project. The topics of the projects will be based on the broad theme of the programme, keeping in mind the American and Indian socio-cultural perspective. The participants will be working in buddy groups mentored under a Faculty Advisor for the programme. The participants are expected to approach the project individually and also work as a team with their respective groups.

A brief proposal is to be submitted by the students to the Faculty Coordinator. There will be pre-project presentation along with submission of the hard copy of the project. The final project presentation will be followed by a discussion on the group's topic and a Q & A session. The projects will be judged on the basis of certain criteria such as-Observation, Interpretation, Suggestive Solution and Feasible Action, among others. Two of the best presentations will be awarded prizes and commendation certificates.
