

Students have always been the biggest strength of SRCC. Their intelligence and hard work has enabled SRCC to retain its position on top, thus maintaining its course to becoming the College of global choice. Let us put our hands together for our students whose achievements we applaud with great pride.

It's our great pleasure to announce that Ayush Mittal is the overall topper of the GBO programme. Ipshita Aggarwal is the overall topper of the B Com Hons programme. Hardik Wadhwa has topped the BA Hons Economics programme overall. Indeed our students have worked very hard to keep the flag of SRCC flying high. Likewise, in the extra-curriculars, a heroic performance by Mrityunjay Sharma won him a place in the Guinness Book of World Records for playing continuously on the keyboards for 127 hours. The College is proud to acknowledge the hard work and dedication of all the student achievers in the printed report.

None of this would have been possible without the able guidance of the faculty in these challenging times of flux. We therefore must applaud the efforts of the faculty who have shown such remarkable adaptability and delivered quality instruction in times of intense syllabi, course and





scheme revisions.

The administrative staff has done a wonderful job of liaising with the University and the UGC in these times of change. We would like to place our appreciation on record.

As the country moves forward on the path to development, attempting the herculean task of carrying its people along, newer challenges keep emerging every moment. The needs of the people, its industry, its services sector keep changing. The University also keeps evolving its examination scheme, pedagogy and content to meet and exceed the current and future requirements of the country. The titration of the content to arrive at the optimal syllabus during successive academic sessions has placed immense demands on the faculty and students. The CBCS is the latest effort to find this perfect mix.

In line with the vision of the CBCS, student mobility and inter-disciplinarity, the College has set up an Internal Quality Assurance Cell to enhance the best practices and quality of learning. Currently the Cell is examining ways in which a switch could be made from rote learning to interactive activity based learning and to replace podium teaching with participative learning. We intend to actively move away from text book learning to research based learning, including field work, case studies, project work etc.

From our library resources to College Magazine, dramatics to debating, literary and artistic pursuits showcase the rich vibrancy of our talent pool. We need to give a structured format to these cross disciplinary pursuits by actively embracing the provisions of the CBCS, and offering a greater range of electives, to bring innovation to the learning process.

The CBCS has, theoretically, enabled a mechanism for credit transfer across Universities. Once the modalities are worked out, the long pursued vision of the College, of letting our students do a part of their courses in specialized institutions and Universities abroad could finally be fulfilled.

Over an extended period of time, SRCC has put in place various MOUs with partner institutes and universities abroad. Several international conferences were co-hosted with reputed Universities in the USA and Africa. The effort to reignite those linkages now has begun in earnest. Soon, it would be possible to see students and visiting faculty members of various nationalities in the SRCC campus, and to see many of our students and teachers in our partner institutes abroad.

Closer home, the College will now pursue the formal declaration of the rigorous and demanding Post Graduate Diploma in Global Business Operations as a Masters in Business Administration programme. The College is considering introducing management studies at the undergraduate level. We are hopeful that the University of Delhi will stand by the College in this endeavor.

Under the aegis of the Centre for Professional Development, the College has been conducting focused short term courses for the students. We have organized faculty development programmes, workshops, and

specialized lecture sessions. We are in the process of putting in place the ground work for offering Executive Development Courses, Customised Training Programmes, Consultancies etc.

The college has initiated grants for faculty research, and for publications in national and international journals. SRCC faculty and students can also avail of grants to present papers at seminars and conferences in India and abroad.

Women's Development Cell was inaugurated in October 2015 to formally place on agenda women's development issues like sexual harassment, domestic violence, female foeticide, trafficking etc.

This has been an year where the College has witnessed student interaction with an extraordinary number of distinguished visitors from all walks of life. We thank the Students Union and the numerous Societies for their keen interest in extra-curricular activities, and their phenomenal organizational ability.


All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy. Since the College believes in imparting holistic education, sports and games are given due importance.



To help the students cope with the different phases of Life, career and aspirations, a guest lecture was conducted by **Mr. Harish Mehta, a certified banker from IIB and an Executive Coach**. The session gave the students an opportunity to introspect and answer basic questions like:

- Define who you are and what you do
- Define your purpose, vision, goals
- How to inspire, motivate & influence
- How to express to impress
- Learning the steps to Greatness amongst others.

### **EXPORT MANAGEMENT AND TRADE PROCEDURES VISIT – JNPT, Mumbai**

Commissioned in the year 1989, Jawahar Lal Nehru Port Trust is the largest port in India and ranks 31 amongst the top 100 container ports in the world. Accountable for 56% of total containers handled by all major ports in India, JNPT handled 63.80 million tons of cargo in 2014-15. The visit to JNPT gave the students information on how Trade is facilitated from JNPT to other countries and the process of sending and receiving an import/export consignment.

### **MSME and Their SOCIO-ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT VISIT – DHARAVI, Mumbai**

The visit to Dharavi, the “poor little rich slum” of India was organized in collaboration with “Be The Local” Organization. The visit acquainted the students with Social Entrepreneurship and MSME industries functioning in Dharavi. Dharavi boasts an informal economy in which numerous household enterprises employ majority of the slum residents. Some of the goods manufactured by these industries include leather, textiles and pottery. The annual turnover of these industries in Dharavi is estimated to around \$500 million, including exports. The informal economy aims to be self-sustainable, with people integrating their businesses either vertically or horizontally to support other already operating businesses.

### **ORGANISATIONAL CULTURE AND CORPORATE ETHICS VISIT – TAJ MAHAL PALACE AND TOWERS, Mumbai**

Besides being the most valued jewel in the Taj Hotels Group, the hotel is also a great example in the field of hospitality and service throughout India. A session conducted by Viren A D'Sa, Manager – Customer Experiences, introduced the students to the Organizational Culture at Taj Hotels that made several of its employees come back to the hotel and resume duty while risking their lives during the 2008 Mumbai Terrorist attack, although they were under no obligations to do so.

### **MONEY AND IT'S MOVEMENT- RBI and BSE, Mumbai**

Reserve Bank of India's Coin Museum gave students a deep insight as to how currency came into existence and evolved over a period of time. After this, the students were introduced to the movement of Money by the officials of the Bombay Stock Exchange through a seminar.



### **Project Sattva**

Project Sattva, ongoing project started in 2015, has facilitated access to microfinance and scientific training to women dairy farmers for rearing of high yielding cattle and helped promote women-run milk collection and processing units to provide unadulterated milk and milk products to consumers. The organization has collaborated with National Dairy Research Institute and Arpana Services for technical support and to facilitate microfinance to the community.

Since its inception in April 2015, the project has engaged 11 women directly and has increased their income to Rs. 10,463/month. Through the improved quality of milk and milk products, 920 people have benefitted.

### **Project Azmat**

Project Azmat endeavoured to liberate a community of 60 manual scavengers by providing them a sustainable source of livelihood through development of a micro-enterprise and to facilitate construction of proper toilet systems. The toilets, constructed in collaboration with Sulabh International, conserve water and convert human waste into nutrient rich manure to create a positive environmental impact as well as promoting the agrarian economy of the village. In association with National Safai Karamchari Finance and Development Corporation, the women are being trained in zardozi stitching and



will soon start manufacturing sarees, which will further be distributed by E Ashram.

### **Project Kayakalp**

Project Kayakalp, an initiative to revive the dying art of puppetry, aims to empower traditional puppeteers and other artists of Kathputli colony, Shadipur Depot and expand their income generation possibilities. This academic year, the community has performed 343 shows for organisations like DMRC, Ministry of Environment, Ministry of Culture, Max India Foundation, Maruti, Mahindra and many more. In order to ensure sustainability and independent functioning, Kayakalp has now been registered as a Trust and LLP.

Enactus SRCC, in association with Campus Community Partnership Foundation, organised the C2P CASE Grant Competition. Teams from across India presented their business idea for a social entrepreneurship project, three of which won a grant of ₹120,000 to implement their model.

### ***Film Screening***


On January 21, 2016 , the ELS screened 'Dead Poets Society' for about 100 eager S'rites who critically analysed the movie.

**Piyush Goyal is the Minister of State with Independent Charge for Power, Coal, New and Renewable Energy in the Government of India. He is currently a Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha) and was earlier the National Treasurer of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). He headed the BJP's Information Communication Campaign Committee and oversaw the publicity and advertising campaign of the party including the social media outreach for the Indian General Elections 2014.**

**He is the son of Late Shri Ved Prakash Goyal who had served as a Union Minister for shipping in the Atal Bihari Vajpayee cabinet and was also the treasurer of Bhartiya Janta Party for a long time.**

**He has had a strong academic record - all-India second rank holder Chartered Accountant[3] and second rank holder in Law in Mumbai University. He has participated in Leadership Programs at Yale University (2011), Oxford University (2012) and Princeton University (2013) and is currently pursuing the Owner / President Management (OPM) Program at Harvard Business School. He did his schooling from Don Bosco High School, Matunga.**

**A well-known investment banker, he has advised top corporates on management strategy and growth; also served on the Board of India's largest commercial bank, State Bank of India and Bank of Baroda.**

**Piyush was a member of the Standing Committee on Finance and the Consultative Committee for the Ministry of Defence. An active member of the Managing Committee of Indian Merchants Chamber, he is also involved with NGOs in diverse fields such as tribal education and welfare of the physically challenged (Jaipur Foot).**

**During his 28-year-long political career, he has served on the National Executive and held several important positions in the BJP. He was also nominated by the Government of India to the Task Force for Interlinking of Rivers. He was the Dy. Campaign In-charge for the Parliament elections in 1991 and played a key role at the central level in all elections since 2004.**

**He was the minister-in-waiting for US President Barack Obama who visited India on 26th January, 2015.**
