The eligibility criteria for:

1. Dr. Charat Ram Memorial Scholarship

- a. Students of B. Com(H) and B.A(H) Economics can apply for the scholarship
- b. It is a need-cum-merit scholarship both being given equal weightage
- c. Need is determined by family income up to Rs. 6,00,000 per annum
- d. This scholarship is available for girl students only
- e. Scholarship amount Rs.20,000
- f. Scheme is not available to students receiving any other scholarship

2. Graduate Class of 1961-Diamond Jubilee Scholarship

- a. scholarship of Rs. 30000 per annum to be awarded to a student of BCom(H)/BA(H) Eco final year from 2021-22.
- b. The scholarship would be a merit cum means basis with both given equal weightage.
- c. Merit for the applicants would be determined by a minimum average CGPA of 9 for the preceding four or six semesters (in case a four-year graduation is introduced).
- d. Need would be determined on the basis of the family 's annual income which should be Rs. 6 lakhs or below.
- e. A student awarded this scholarship will not be eligible for any other scholarship.
